The **LLSF** was founded in 1991 by Emmy Award winning Journalist, Linda Lorelle, her husband Lou Gregory and Linda's former colleague Martha Harvey. The **LLSF** has an impressive college enrollment rate of 99% and a graduation rate of 85%. To date, the **LLSF** has awarded over \$4.0 million in college scholarships and has sent more that 350 Houston area students to college, five of whom now serve on the LLSF Board of Directors. From the students served by the **LLSF** each year, approximately 61% are female and 39% are male. Hispanic students form the major portion of recipients (35%) followed by African American (32%) and Caucasian (13%).

The **LLSF** is dedicated to providing college scholarships to a population of students often overlooked by other scholarship funds. Many of our students have average grades, yet they have a burning desire to go to college and are capable of succeeding, if given the support and encouragement they so desperately need. Unlike other scholarship funds, we don't just award them scholarships and say "good luck". The **LLSF** gives them the tools they need to not only change the trajectory of their lives, but their families, as well. As the saying goes, "it takes a village to raise a child." We are the village.

# **UPSKILL**HOUSTON

The Houston region has experienced incredible growth over the last few years, and its economy has been recognized globally as one of opportunity. But in Greater Houston, as in many regions around the globe, too many people lack the skills or credentials they need to compete for 21st century jobs and too many businesses and employers are unable to find the workers they need, when and where they need them. These skills and people gaps have reached critical proportions among Houston's 1.4 million "middle-skills" jobs – advanced technical and craft careers that require education and skills development beyond high school, but less than a four-year college degree.

The Greater Houston Partnership's UpSkill Houston initiative helps address the regional skills gap and people gap. With business executives and employers leading the way, UpSkill brings together industry leaders, educators, community organization representatives and government officials to build a strong talent pipeline for critical careers and to provide opportunities for residents to share in the region's economic prosperity.

# SmartUp Houston: A Pioneering Partnership

The Linda Lorelle Scholarship Fund and the Greater Houston Partnership's UpSkill Houston initiative have forged a pioneering partnership to educate, engage and attract the region's future workforce.

SmartUp Houston is designed to prepare Houston area students for a 2-year or 4-year college and a well-paying career, while helping the region's employers address a critical need to find qualified workers to fill thousands of jobs vital to the success of our industries. "Many of these jobs require more than a high school diploma but less than a 4-year degree, and some starting salaries are as high as \$70,000," says Linda Lorelle, Co-Founder of the Linda Lorelle Scholarship Fund. "Most students don't know that, so we are not only putting greater emphasis on educating students about all of the career options available to them, we have also expanded our scholarship program to include 2-year degrees. We are very excited to partner with the GHP/UpSkill Houston as we broaden our scope and help our region achieve long-term success."
